North Tahoe Public Utility District Hires General Manager

Kings Beach, CA – Lane Lewis, President of the North Tahoe Public Utility District Board of Directors has announced the appointment of Curtis Aaron as the new General Manager/CEO for the District. Aaron has been serving as the Public Works Director for the City of Fontana, California and prior to holding that position he was the Utilities and Street Manager, also, for the City of Fontana. He will assume his new role with the NTPUD effective April 7th.

President Lewis noted: “Mr. Aaron brings over 20 years of work in the water, wastewater and public works field. He has an extensive background and experience in the area of Public Works budgeting, implementation of Capital Improvement Projects and policies and procedures. We are enthusiastic about his coming to join the District.”

The NTPUD recently completed a national recruitment for the General Manager position that was left vacant when former General Manager Steve Rogers resigned to take the job of Town Manager for the Town of Yountville in Napa County. The District received 55 applications for the position. From that pool, eight (8) applicants were chosen for review by the full Board and four (4) candidates interviewed for the position.

“The Board was extremely pleased with the quality of candidates that applied for the position,” said John Bergmann, Director and Chair of the Recruitment Committee. “It was a tough selection out of the final candidates but we are confident that Mr. Aaron was the best match for the District.

Aaron is a graduate of Arizona State University with a Bachelors of Science Degree in Health Science/Biology. He is an avid boater and enjoys the outdoors. Mr. Aaron states, “I am excited about this wonderful opportunity to serve the Board of Directors and residents of the North Tahoe Public Utility District, and it is my hope to continue to provide the high quality of customer service our customers have come to expect.” Aaron will reside in Kings Beach with his wife, Marty, and their two dogs.

The North Tahoe Public Utility District provides sewer service to the residents of Kings Beach, Tahoe Vista, Carnelian Bay, Cedar Flat and Agate Bay and water service to some of those communities. The NTPUD owns, manages and maintains the North Tahoe Regional Park and the Tahoe Vista Recreation Area which provide active and passive recreation opportunities to residents and visitors. In addition, the NTPUD owns and/or maintains all of the public beaches in the District including King Beach State Recreation Area, Coon Street Boat Launch and Secline Beach to name just a few. The North Tahoe Community Conference Center in downtown Kings Beach is also owned and managed by the NTPUD.
