North Tahoe Public Utility District Tahoe Unleashed Dog Park Remains Closed for the Winter

(Tahoe Vista, California) - The North Tahoe Public Utility District (NTPUD) would like to remind residents and visitors that the Tahoe Unleashed Dog Park at the North Tahoe Regional Park is closed for the season and will reopen once the snow recedes. The fenced, off-leash portion of the park is closed for pet safety because the enclosure gate is blocked by snow and ice. Please do not attempt access to the park to prevent damaging the gate. Dogs on a leash are still welcome in the North Tahoe Regional Park.

The Tahoe Unleashed Dog Park opened last October primarily through the efforts of volunteers and community fundraising along with the support and assistance of the District. Countless locals and visitors have enjoyed this park amenity along with their four-legged friends.

Plans for a more rustic and wild portion of the dog park called “the outback” are currently underway for Summer 2016. Help Dog Day in the Park raise the final \$4000 still needed to complete the dog park by visiting www.tahoeunleashed.com to make a donation. Dog Day in the Park is a 501c3 organization created to raise money to build the dog park and help to support animal welfare organizations in the region.
