North Tahoe Public Utility District to Recruit for General Manager

Tahoe Vista, CA – The North Tahoe Public Utility District Board of Directors announced during a November 25, 2014 Special Board Meeting that action was taken to move forward with recruitment for a new General Manager. CFO Larry Marple will be Interim General Manager during this recruitment process.

The announcement was made following a Closed Session General Manager's Review at the Special Board Meeting on November 25, 2014.

A Personnel Committee meeting will take place on Tuesday, December 2, 2014 at 2:00 PM at the North Tahoe Event Center. Current members of the Personnel Committee members are Director Tim Ferrell and Director Phil Thompson. The Committee will meet to discuss agenda items for the December 9, 2014 Board meeting at which time the recruitment will be discussed in open session with the full Board.

"The Board looks forward to a recruitment process that will enhance the District's community outreach, constituent confidence and public participation," said North Tahoe Public Utility District Board President Lane Lewis. "We have full confidence in our staff to handle all aspects of the District's operations during this transition. The Board thanks Paul Schultz for his dedicated service and professionalism while working for the District over the last five (5) years. We wish him the best in his future endeavors."

Paul Schultz, PE was hired as Manager of Planning and Engineering by then General Manager Curtis Aaron in April 2010 and was appointed by the Board of Directors to the position of General Manager in April 2011.

The North Tahoe Public Utility District provides sewer and water service to the residents of Kings Beach, Tahoe Vista, Carnelian Bay, Cedar Flat and Agate Bay. The North Tahoe Event Center, North Tahoe Regional Park and Tahoe Vista Recreation Area and Boat Launch are owned and operated by the District and provide recreation opportunities to residents and visitors.
