North Tahoe Public Utility District November 2016 Election Information

(Tahoe Vista, CA) Last November, the North Tahoe Public Utility District Board of Directors adopted Ordinance 388 to make a change to "at large" elections for the November 2016 election. During the November election, the Board will also include a ballot measure, Measure E, asking voters if they are in favor of making the change permanent.

This change to voting "at large" allows all candidates to run for all Board positions available during that election cycle. Candidates receiving the most votes overall are elected, without regard for a specific seat.

Three (3) members of the Board of Directors are up for re-election in November, 2016: John Bergmann, Tim Ferrell, and Phil Thompson. (*Please note that the article published in the Sierra Sun on Wednesday, July 20, 2016 listed Director S. Lane Lewis instead of Director Tim Ferrell as being up for election. Director Lewis' seat on the Board runs through November 2018. Additionally, the article stated that "candidates must choose the seat number for which they wish to run," however, the change to "at large" allows candidates to run for all Board positions available during the election cycle without regard for a specific seat.)*
