## **North Tahoe Regional Park Announces Winter Hours**

Kings Beach, CA – Beginning Monday, November 22, 2010 the North Tahoe Regional Park and its facilities will be open from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM. All vehicles must be removed from the Park before 5:00 PM.


Currently all other facilities that are owned, operated or managed by the District have been closed for the winter. Two heated restrooms are open daily from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM at Kings Beach State Recreation Area.

The North Tahoe Public Utility District provides sewer and water service to the residents of Kings Beach, Tahoe Vista, Carnelian Bay, Cedar Flat and Agate Bay. The District owns, manages and maintains the North Tahoe Regional Park in Tahoe Vista which provides recreation opportunities to residents and visitors. In addition, the District owns and/or maintains all of the public beaches in the District including Kings Beach State Recreation Area, Tahoe Vista Recreation Area, and Secline Beach to name just a few.

The North Tahoe Event Center in downtown Kings Beach is also owned and managed by the District.
