North Tahoe Public Utility District Board of Directors hears presentation on Placer County-Wide Transportation Investment Plan

(Kings Beach, CA) – At their October 11, 2016 regular meeting, the Board of Directors heard a presentation from Jaime Wright, Executive Director of the Truckee North Tahoe Transportation Management Association with the facts of Measure M, the Placer County-wide Transportation Investment Plan on the November 8th ballot.

Ms. Wright explained how the plan would be structured and the benefits it would bring to eastern Placer County and the residents of the North Tahoe Public Utility District.
