North Tahoe Public Utility District to Host Sustainable Landscaping Workshop on August 20

Kings Beach, CA - The North Tahoe Public Utility District has partnered with the Tahoe Resource Conservation District and the University of California Extension Master Gardeners to bring a Sustainable Landscaping Workshop to the North Tahoe Event Center in Kings Beach on August 20, 2013 from 6 – 8 PM.

The purpose of the event is to provide our customers with some hints and tips to save water and thereby save money! You will learn about water saving technology and practices, water-wise landscaping techniques, turf removal techniques and re-landscaping ideas, yard fertility practices for healthier turf and clean water, and turf irrigation scheduling and seasonal maintenance.

This workshop is made possible from a grant through California Proposition 84 Grant Funds for water conservation and the North Tahoe Public Utility District.

Like all public water systems in California, the District is required to reduce water consumption 20% by 2020. In order to achieve this goal, we need your help! This workshop is one way that you can obtain valuable information on conserving your water and helping to meet our reduction requirement. Please plan on attending this important event.

If all our customers work together to contain, or even reduce their water usage, it can help to offset increasing electricity costs for treatment and pumping of water. While capital improvements and

regular maintenance will not go away, if customer's water usage can remain constant or even be reduced, it helps the District control our costs.

This event is free and open to the public. Please bring your friends and neighbors! Parking for this event is free for all attendees. Light refreshments will be served and although you are not required to RSVP we hope that you'll "Like" the North Tahoe Public Utility District's Facebook page and then sign up on our event page.
