SEASONAL MAINTENANCE WORKER
WATER/SEWER

DEFINITION

Under direction, assist in the maintenance and operation of the District's wastewater collection, water storage, and water distribution systems, and operate various equipment used to repair and maintain those systems. Performs other related work as may be assigned.

TYPICAL TASKS

As part of a crew, performs required labor involved in the construction and maintenance of projects including laying pipe, trenching, back filling, pavement cutting, ditch digging, manhole and line cleaning, and pipe repair. Safely operates a variety of related power construction and maintenance equipment.

KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITY

- Basic knowledge of methods, tools, materials, and equipment used in the construction, repair, operation, and maintenance of sewer and water systems and associated facilities
- Knowledge of safe work methods and related safety practices pertaining to the trade and the ability to read and interpret safety rules
- Ability to follow oral and written directions
- Requires mechanical ability
- Ability to establish and maintain cooperative relationships with other employees

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

Education: Any combination of education and experience equivalent to graduation from the twelfth grade.

Experience: Prefer one year of experience in construction, repair, and operation and maintenance of water and sewer systems.

License: Possession of a valid California or Nevada Driver's License with a driving record satisfactory to the District and the District's insurance carrier.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS AND WORKING ENVIRONMENT

Frequent standing, walking, talking, hearing, use of hands to operate objects and tools, frequently required to climb or balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, crawl, safely lift and/or move up to 50 pounds. Working environment is outdoors with exposure to all weather conditions.
