The District contracts with an in-house caterer to provide customers from out of the area the convenience of working with a caterer who has been chosen through a public process and is familiar with our venue and customer base. The In-House Caterer has the advantage of being the first recommendation of the Event Center staff when customers are seeking a caterer for an event being held in the building. Event Center staff and in-house caterer form a collaborative team approach in marketing, planning and contracting with potential customers seeking a place for their event.


