## North Tahoe Public Utility District Seeks New Members for the Recreation and Parks Commission

(Tahoe Vista, California) - Are you a resident within the North Tahoe Public Utility District boundaries interested in parks and recreation looking for an opportunity to serve your community? The North Tahoe Public Utility District (District) is seeking interested community members for volunteer positions on the District's Recreation and Parks Commission. Two adult seats and two youth seats are open to be filled.

The Commission makes decisions and awards Youth Trust Fund scholarships and makes recommendations to the Board about policies, pricing and park rules. Current projects include fundraising for the Playground at the North Tahoe Regional Park, developing a policy about advertising and donations for parks, and assisting with facilitation of a sailing program in Kings Beach.


Community involvement is extremely important! The Commission meets monthly and meetings last two to three hours. The Commissioners are also asked for additional time

commitments for special events, e.g. Pancake Breakfast or other community events, to share information on the Friends of the Park Fund and other Commission activities.

The Recreation and Parks Commission is an advisory commission to the North Tahoe Public Utility District Board of Directors on matters of Recreation and Parks. The Commission is a liaison between the District Board and the community and consists of five (5) adult members and two (2) student members. All Commissioners must be residents of the District and the student members must be full-time, 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade students in good standing. Applicants must fill out an application that is available on our website, [www.ntpud.org](http://www.ntpud.org) clicking on the About tab and then Recreation and Parks Commission. All applications will be submitted to the Board of Directors for consideration of their appointment.
