Coon Street Boat Launch Open through Labor Day

Kings Beach, CA – Coon Street Boat Launch will be open normal hours of 7:00 AM – 7:00 PM through the Labor Day weekend and then will close for the remainder of the season to accommodate the Brook Avenue Sewer Line Replacement Project taking place in the area.

Tahoe Vista Recreation Area (TVRA) Boat Launch will remain open 7 days a week from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM until weather or Lake level forces its closure.

The Brook Avenue Sewer Line Replacement project will replace the existing sewer mains and service laterals in Brook Avenue and in Coon Street between Brook Avenue and Brockway Vista Avenue. A new sewer main, manholes, and service laterals will also be installed in SR28 between Coon Street and Bear Street in order to abandon a mid-block sewer main in which the District does not have adequate access. It is necessary for the District to complete this project prior start of construction of the Kings Beach Commercial Core Improvement Project.

TVRA will continue to be staffed in compliance with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's (TRPA) Blue Boating and Aquatic Invasive Species Inspections and all boats being launched must have the proper documentation prior to launching. When no staff is present, the launch will be closed and locked.

Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) Blue Boating and Aquatic Invasive Species Inspections

All inspections must be done at Offsite inspection stations. In the North Shore area of Lake Tahoe they are available at Northstar-at-Tahoe on Highway 267 and Alpine Meadows on Highway 89.
