North Tahoe Public Utility District General Manager Resigns

Kings Beach, CA – The North Tahoe Public Utility District Board of Director's announced that they have accepted the resignation of General Manager Curtis Aaron effective December 17, 2010. He is relocating back to Southern California due to family concerns. Mr. Aaron joined the District in March 2007.

An Open House will be held on Thursday, December 9, 2010 at the North Tahoe Event Center to bid farewell to Mr. Aaron and wish him well in his future endeavors.

"Curtis has made significant contributions to the District in his short time here," says Lane Lewis, President of the Board of Directors. "In addition to the significant Capital projects that have been completed in his tenure, the District has reduced spending and improved administrative operations. He will be missed."

Mr. Paul Schultz, Planning and Engineering Manager, has been named the Acting General Manager upon Mr. Aaron's departure. The North Tahoe Public Utility District Board of Directors will discuss the next steps related to their search for a new General Manager at the December 7, 2010 Board meeting.

The North Tahoe Public Utility District provides sewer and water service to the residents of Kings Beach, Tahoe Vista, Carnelian Bay, Cedar Flat and Agate Bay. The District owns, manages and maintains the North Tahoe Regional Park in Tahoe Vista which provides

recreation opportunities to residents and visitors. In addition, the District owns and/or maintains all of the public beaches in the District including Kings Beach State Recreation Area, Tahoe Vista Recreation Area, and Secline Beach to name just a few. The North Tahoe Event Center in downtown Kings Beach is also owned and managed by the District.
