North Tahoe Public Utility District Unveils New Map for the North Tahoe Regional Park

(Tahoe Vista, California) - The North Tahoe Public Utility District has unveiled a new map for the North Tahoe Regional Park. This map will update and replace the one currently in circulation that was last updated sometime in the late 1980's. This new map reflects all the new facilities that have been installed in the Park, provides current information on the rentals available within the Park and information on the District's Friends of the Park Fund.

"We are excited to provide a new and updated resource for the residents and visitors that come to the North Tahoe Regional Park to recreate," says Kathy Long, Parks and Facilities Manager for the District. "We are hopeful that this new map will bring more people to enjoy the Park and the many amenities that it has to offer."

The map is available at the North Tahoe Public Utility District offices in Tahoe Vista or the North Tahoe Event Center in Kings Beach. In the coming weeks, the District will also deliver maps to local lodging properties for their guests. If local lodging properties would like to pick the maps up from the District offices, please contact Pam Lefrancois at 530-546-4212 and she will put a package together for you for pickup.

The map was redesigned by SmallPond Studios in Truckee, CA.

The North Tahoe Public Utility District provides sewer and water service to the residents of Kings Beach, Tahoe Vista, Carnelian Bay, Cedar Flat and Agate Bay. The District owns, manages and maintains the North Tahoe Regional Park in Tahoe Vista which provides

recreation opportunities to residents and visitors. In addition, the NTPUD owns and/or maintains all of the public beaches in the District including Kings Beach State Recreation Area, Tahoe Vista Recreation Area, and Secline Beach to name just a few. The North Tahoe Event Center in downtown Kings Beach is also owned and managed by the NTPUD.
