North Tahoe Regional Park Ballfield Named for Placer County Detective Mike Davis, Jr.

Kings Beach, CA - The North Tahoe Public Utility District has partnered with the Placer County Deputy Sheriff's Association to rename Ball Field #2 in the North Tahoe Regional Park "Placer County Detective Mike Davis, Jr. Field." Detective Davis was killed while on duty on October 24, 2014. Detective Davis had been an employee at the North Tahoe Event Center and a volunteer fire fighter with the North Tahoe Fire District prior to his decision to become a Deputy Sheriff. During this tragic incident Sacramento County Sheriff's Deputy Danny Oliver was also killed in the line of duty.

On August 22, 2015 the Placer County Sheriff's Office, Placer County Deputy Sheriff's Association, and the 1035 Foundation will be present to dedicate the field and play a benefit softball game. The Community is welcome and invited to attend the dedication ceremony and the game in order to pay tribute to Detective Davis.

At the December 2014 Board of Directors meeting when this request was presented, Detective Sergeant David Hunt presented a brief biography of Michael Davis, Jr.

Michael Davis, Jr. moved to the North Tahoe area as a teenager to live in Kings Beach with his grandparents, Bob and Joanne Davis, after his father had been killed while serving as a police officer in Southern California. Detective Davis had worked at the North Tahoe Public Utility District from 1991-1995 at the North Tahoe Community Conference Center (now the Event Center) while also


volunteering at North Tahoe Fire. He left the employ of the District to work as a police officer in Auburn before returning to Placer County Sheriff's Department. He was killed in the line of duty on duty on October 24, 2014, while protecting the citizens of Placer County.

The Board voted to approve the renaming of the Field as recommended by the Recreation and Parks Commission determining the specifics of the agreement once the proposed change was noticed in the paper allowing for comments from the public.

"The District is proud and honored to work with the Placer County Deputy Sheriff's Association to honor Detective Davis through the naming of this field," said General Manager Duane Whitelaw who had hired Detective Davis when he was the Park and Facilities Manager for the District in 1991."

In order to honor Detective Davis, the Placer County Deputy Sheriff's Association will come together for an annual work day each year to assist with maintenance of the field and host an annual fundraiser/charity game or tournament. In addition, the PCDSA has purchased a new scoreboard for the field with the new name and a plaque will be installed at the field remembering Detective Davis.

The North Tahoe Public Utility District provides sewer and water service to the residents of Kings Beach, Tahoe Vista, Carnelian Bay, Cedar Flat and Agate Bay. The North Tahoe Regional Park, Tahoe Vista Recreation Area and Boat Launch and North Tahoe Event Center are owned and operated by the District and provide recreation opportunities to residents and visitors.
