Ski Trails at the North Tahoe Regional Park

Large incense cedars tower over you as your skis glide along the groomed trails at the North Tahoe Regional Park. Another group admires the view as they snowshoe through the snow covered forest. The trails at the North Tahoe Regional Park are enjoyed by families and groups of friends out enjoying a beautiful day in the Tahoe winter. The ski trails are a fun and inexpensive way to spend the day enjoying the outdoors.

The North Tahoe Public Utility District grooms the trails in the Park a couple times a week, as snow conditions allow. When the trails are groomed, the District's home page is updated whenever the trails are groomed to reflect the current conditions.

"The District is pleased to be able to provide this valuable amenity to its residents," says Kathy Long, Parks and Facilities Manager for the North Tahoe Public Utility District. "While we are not able to provide the near perfect grooming, rentals and other amenities that a formal cross country ski area can provide, our trails are great for a day out with family or friends."

Entry to the North Tahoe Regional Park is free for North Tahoe Public Utility District residents with their Resident's sticker, but non-residents pay only a \$3 parking fee. For those without their own cross country skis or snowshoes, almost any ski rental shop in the area can rent the appropriate gear. Additional donations to support grooming and other park maintenance are always appreciated and there is a fee collection box at the trail head in the upper parking lot.

The North Tahoe Public Utility District provides sewer and water service to the residents of Kings Beach, Tahoe Vista, Canelian Bay, Cedar Flat and Agate Bay. The District owns, manages and maintains the North Tahoe Regional Park in Tahoe Vista which provides recreation opportunities to residents and visitors. In addition, the District owns and/or maintains

all of the public beaches in the District including Kings Beach State Recreation Area, Tahoe Vista Recreation Area, and Secline Beach to name just a few. The North Tahoe Event Center in downtown Kings Beach is also owned and managed by the District.
