

North Tahoe Public Utility District Weather Based Smart Irrigation Controller Rebate Credit Application

Weather Based Smart Irrigation Controller Rebate Credit Program Guidelines

- 1. NTPUD water customers are eligible for rebate credit. A water customer is defined as the customer whose name is on the billing account.
- 2. Application must include copies of all receipts.
- 3. Irrigation Controller must have been purchased after June 2, 2020.
- 4. Rebate credit will be applied to the customer's water bill.
- 5. Irrigation controllers must be installed within NTPUD's water boundaries. NTPUD staff reserves the option to perform inspections of all installations prior to applying rebate credit.
- 6. Customers will receive a rebate credit up to a total of \$500 per parcel. The rebate credit may be a combination of the cost of the controller and the cost of installation, up to the maximum rebate credit amount of \$500 per parcel.
- 7. Rebate credit will only apply to weather based "smart" irrigation controllers that are EPA WaterSense certified and/or contain moisture sensors and/or are controlled with a rain sensor, and are programmable to meet the District's watering restrictions.
- 8. Rebate credit is only applicable for existing irrigation systems.
