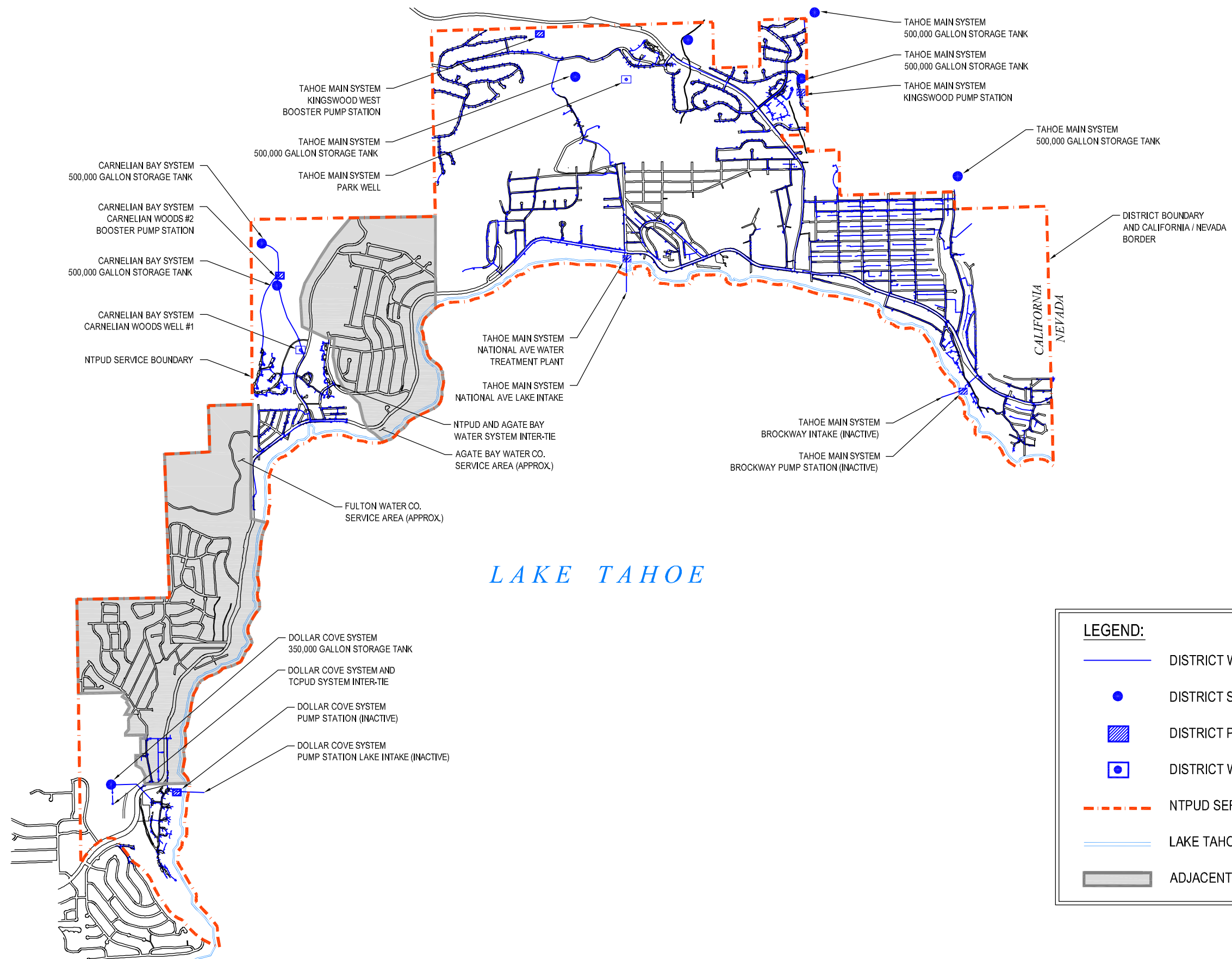
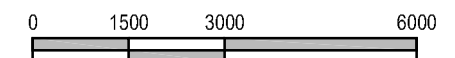


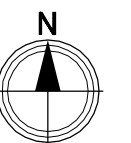
FIGURE 2: DISTRICT SYSTEMS MAP

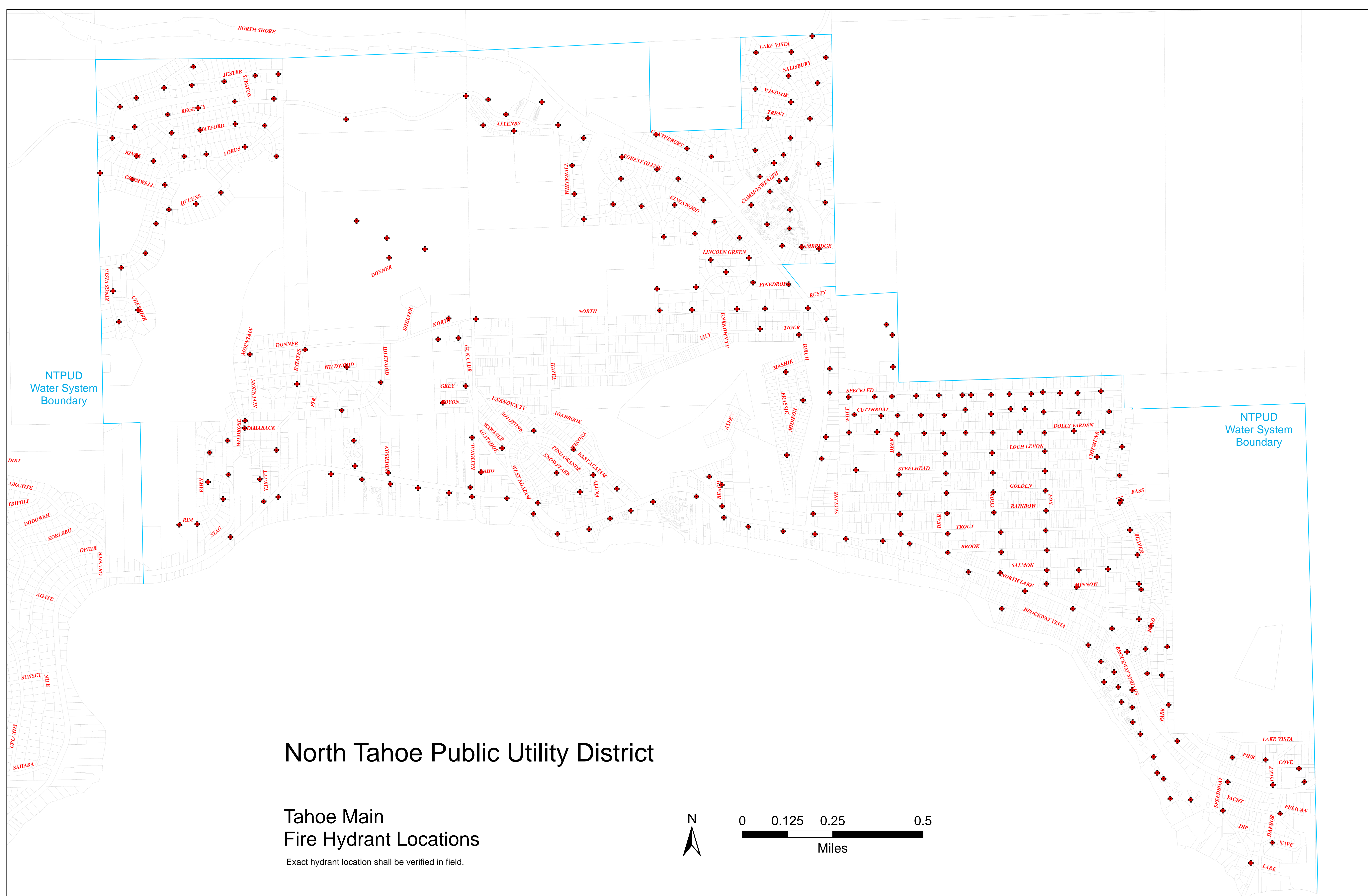

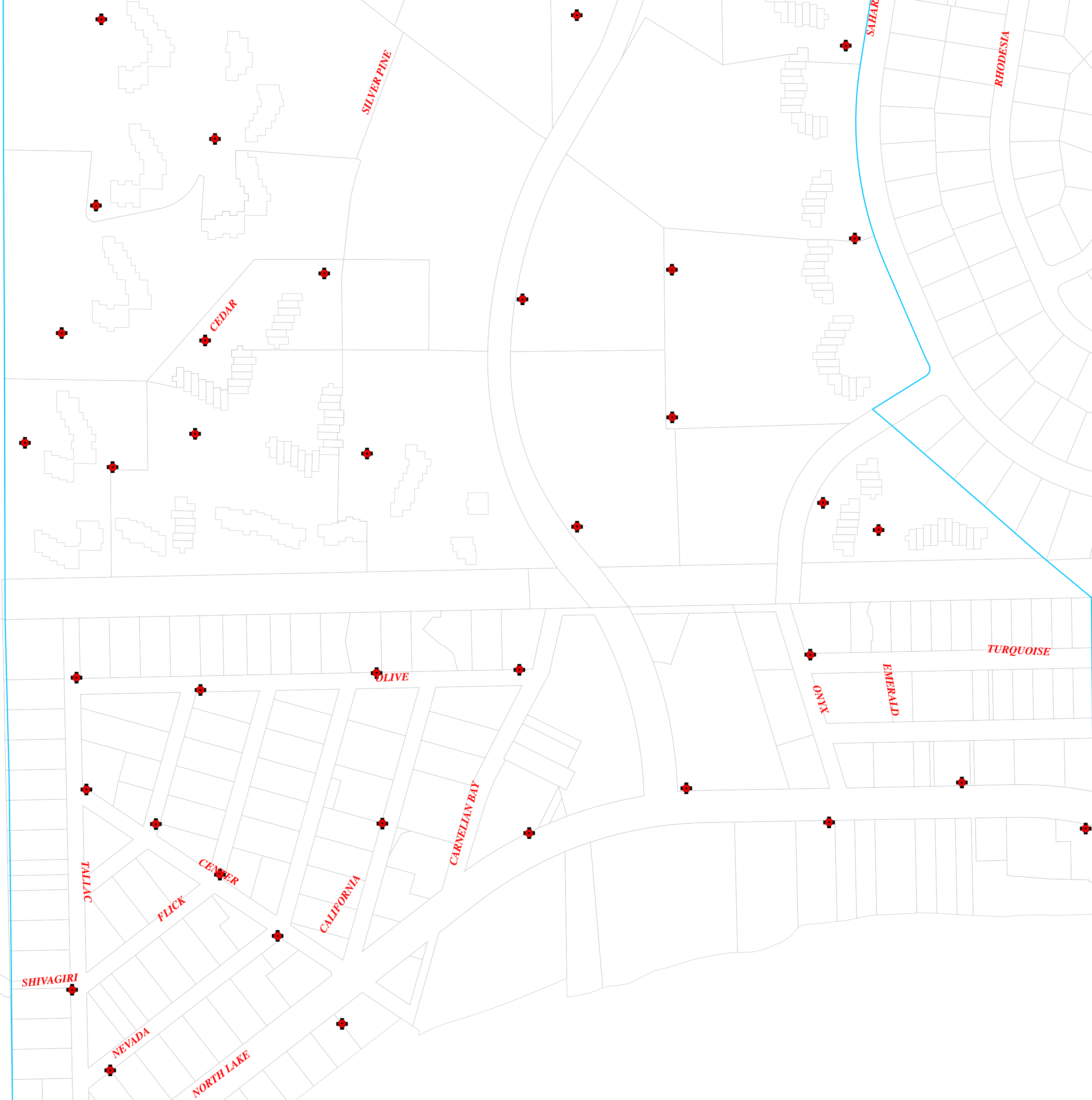

Boundary



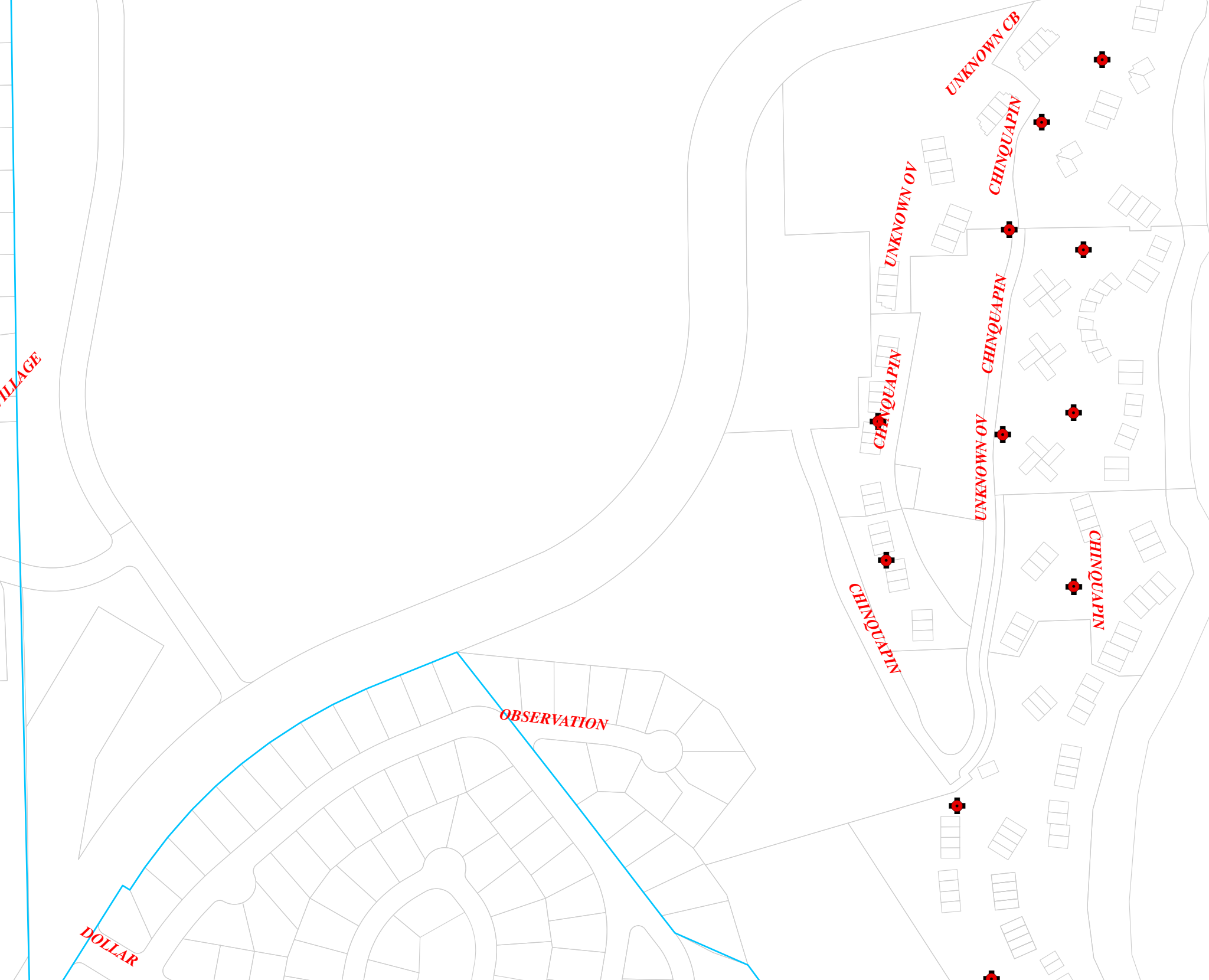
