As a key member of the District's Senior Management Team, the CFO will oversee all financial operations and ensure the long-term fiscal stability and transparency of the District. This position requires a strategic thinker with a deep understanding of financial management, governmental accounting, and business operations. The CFO works collaboratively with all departments, managing both operating and capital budgets and ensuring financial stability throughout the District. The successful applicant will support the District and management team placing an emphasis on financial transparency for all transactions and public reporting.

Reporting to the General Manager/CEO, this position directs the operations of the District's Finance, Accounting, and Customer Service Departments. Areas of responsibility include, but are not limited to - budget development and administration, financial transaction processing, recordkeeping and reporting, payroll, utility billing, purchasing, accounts payable, auditing, investment, and financial systems software.

The CFO shall carry out the functions of the Accountant defined in the California Public Utilities Code Sections 16111(b) and 16112 as appointed by the Board of Directors of the North Tahoe Public Utility District. This position will regularly prepare, present, and discuss financial information to the District's Finance Committee and Board of Directors.
